High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

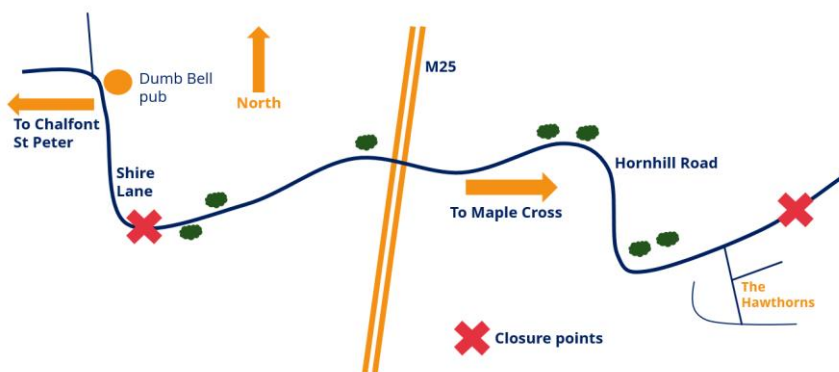
Resurfacing works on Hornhill Road, Maple Cross

Following on from the widening and improvements to Hornhill Road earlier this year, resurfacing of the road can now take place.

These works will be between 9.30am and 4pm from Monday 24 June to Friday 28 June.

The road will be closed between Shire Lane and Woodland Road during those times with a diversion in place.

Access to businesses will be maintained.
